Mogas (Super Unleaded Ron 95)

The percentage decrease in the retail price of Mogas is 2.15%, i.e less than the 4% ceiling. Therefore the retail price of Mogas is maintained at Rs 45.95 per litre.

The percentage decrease in the retail price of Gas Oil is 6.08%, i.e more than the 4% ceiling. Therefore the retail price of Gas Oil is now fixed at Rs 35.50 per litre.
